Thanks, i'll post the script that works If it helps anyone else it seems to work well os_: I do see a bug in that script, though. Maybe it needs to be "patch --revert" instead of "patch -p0"? MajorNSC: No, I patched it with "patch -p0", but the script seems to expect a reversed patch and I'm not sure why it would do that os_: I didn't follow what you were doing with it, but I do see the issue. I'll give that a try. MajorNSC: One of the important things the script does is to tell it what the files' prior states were. That's why I'm wondering why it would expect a "reversed" patch and not a "normal" one os_: My issue is I see the error you're getting. It does a good job of explaining it, too. MajorNSC: I don't see it, so if you could please tell me what the error you're seeing is that would be great. And if you can share how you patched it I'd love to see that. I'm not sure if that was the same error

I'm seeing but I know that script is supposed to revert the patch If you think that might help os_: yeah, that looks right. It's meant to revert a "patch" instead of one where you put the file back to what it was originally hmmm, that's frustrating os_: but I don't think that's what 82157476af

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
